#### 3. OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHANCELLOR

The Chancellor welcomed all the members and informed that the previous Academic Council Meeting was conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020 through online due to the pandemic. The Chancellor extended a special welcome to the new Vice Chancellor and the Pro Vice Chancellor. She informed that Dr. S.N. Sridhara has been appointed as Vice Chancellor of the University based on the recommendation of Search cum Selection Committee. She said that the 11th Convocation is scheduled to be held on 11th January 2021 and the Chief Guest for the Convocation is Dr. G. Satheesh Reddy, Secretary, Department of Defence R&D

and Chairman, DRDO. Due to pandemic, only Ph.D. scholars, P.G. graduands and Rank holders will be receiving their degrees physically. The Agenda items for the meeting includes: Introduction of new courses, proposed intake, amendments to the Academic Regulations, NIRF Rankings, etc. She expressed her deep concern about the NIRF Ranking as we need to increase in the number of publications to achieve better ranking in the future. She suggested to nominate outside Supervisors for Ph.D. research scholars in order to facilitate wider variety of areas / disciplines for publications.

The Vice Chancellor welcomed all members and thanked the Management for the opportunity provided to him to serve as the Vice Chancellor of this great Institution. He assured to deliver the best of his capacity and take the University to the next level.
