INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARTICIPANTS

1. Reception

- Participating teams shall intimate or report to the Secretary about the date and time of their arrival, well in advance.
- There are several passenger buses are shuttling between Tambaram to Padur. Similarly from Kilambakkam to Padur where the university is located.
- Other state teams arrival from Egmore Railway station or Chennai M.G.R. Central Railway Station shuttling trains are available upto Tambaram to reach padur by bus.
- Buses from Central Station to Hindustan University - **Bus No : 102, 221**
- Buses from Tambaram Station to Kilambakkam - **Bus No : 515, 555, 517**
- Buses from Kilambakkam to Hindustan University - **Bus No : 555 S**
- Buses from Koyambedu Bus Terminus to University - **Bus No : 570, 570X**
- The reception counter will be available at Hindustan Institute of Technology & Science Campus from 20th to 21st February, 2026 from 6.00 am onwards.

2. Accommodation & Boarding

- Teams will be provided with free, unfurnished accommodation inside the University campus hostels or classrooms. A nominal charge of **₹100 per person** per day will be collected for a mattress.
- Teams are requested to bring their own bedsheets, pillows, locks, and keys.
- Accommodation will be made available **12 hours prior** to the commencement of the matches. Teams that do not qualify for the subsequent rounds are required to vacate the accommodation immediately.
- Each team will have to pay **Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only)** as caution deposit, which will be refunded at the time of departure of the team after adjusting the cost of damages.
- The organizing committee has made arrangements for providing food in the campus itself on request. The team managers should book the meal at least on the previous day by paying the amount and collecting coupons. Food Menu will be (South Indian) and the cost will be **Rs. 250** (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) per person per day.

3. Managers' Meeting

- The meeting of the Managers will be held on **21 February, 2026 at 4.00 pm** in the University Campus. All Team managers are requested to be present.

4. Eligibility & Documents

- Four copies of the Eligibility proformas of the players duly typed and signed by the Registrar / Director of Physical Education / Sports officers of the participating University along with player's Identity cards & a copy of subscription receipt & AIU Registration Fee Receipt (**Rs. 5000/-**) obtained from AIU New Delhi are to be handed over to the organizing secretary at the time of registration.

- To support the eligibility details of students participating in the Inter University Beach Volleyball Men & Women Championship, players enrolled in the Undergraduate (UG) course must submit photocopies of their Diploma/10th and/or +12th/intermediate pass certificates. For those enrolled in the Postgraduate (PG) course, photocopies of the 10th, +12, and Graduation certificates, along with the Aadhar Card, ABC ID must be submitted to the organizing Secretary. These documents should be duly attested by the competent authority. Students without the aforementioned documents will not be allowed to participate in the Inter University Tournament.

5. Officiating Charges

- The Manager of every team should **pay Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only)** per match as officiating charges to the organizing Secretary / Ground In-charge officers before the commencement of their match.
- The teams should be ready One Hour before the commencement of their matches.

6. Protest

- Any protest shall be submitted in writing by the Team Manager to the Technical Committee or Organizing Secretary within 120 minutes from the occurrence of the incident, along with a protest fee of **Rs. 3,000/-**.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL – RULES AND REGULATIONS

All participating teams are hereby informed that the Beach Volleyball competition will be conducted strictly in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed by the **Fédération Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB)**. All teams are advised to carefully read the guidelines and ensure full compliance at all times.

1. Team Composition

- Each team shall consist of two (2) players only.
- Player names must be duly entered on the official score sheet prior to the match.
- One player shall be designated as the Team Captain.
- A team may be accompanied by one (1) Manager (2 + 1 composition).
- No external assistance or coaching will be permitted during the match.

2. Uniform and Equipment

- Players shall wear shorts/bathing suits with jersey or tank top.
- The 1st Referee may authorize players to compete barefoot, with socks, or with shoes.
- Jerseys must bear numbers 1 and 2, clearly visible on the chest or front.
- Players may wear glasses or lenses at their own risk.
- Wearing objects that may cause injury or provide an unfair/artificial advantage is strictly prohibited.

3. Match Format and Scoring

- Matches shall be played on a best of three (3) sets basis.
- 1st Set – 21 points
- 2nd Set – 21 points
- 3rd Set (deciding set) – 15 points
- A minimum lead of two (2) points is mandatory to win a set.
- The team winning two sets shall be declared the winner.
- In the event of a 1-1 tie, a deciding third set will be played.

4. Court Switching

- Teams shall change ends:
- Every 7 points in the 1st and 2nd sets
- Every 5 points in the 3rd set
- Switching must be carried out without delay.

5. Timeouts

- Each team is entitled to one (1) timeout per set, lasting 30 seconds.
- A Technical Timeout shall be applied automatically when the combined score reaches 21 points.
- No technical timeout shall be provided in the 3rd set.
- During timeouts and intervals, players must remain in the designated player area.

6. Service Order

- Service order shall be either 1-2 or 2-1.
- Any service order fault shall result in one point awarded to the opponent.

7. Playing Regulations

- Each team is permitted a maximum of three (3) hits, including the block.
- A player may not hit the ball twice consecutively, except after blocking.
- Simultaneous contact by teammates shall count as two hits.
- The ball may contact any part of the body.
- Penetration into the opponent's court is permitted provided there is no interference.
- The server must execute the serve within 5 seconds.
- Screening or obstructing the opponent's view is prohibited.
- Blocking the service is not allowed.
- Drop shots are not permitted.

8. Attack Faults

- Open-handed finger attack.
- Non-rigid fingertip contact.
- Open-hand pass not perpendicular to the shoulders, except when setting to a teammate.

9. Toss

- The winner of the toss shall choose either:
- To serve, or
- To receive the service.

10. Warm-up

- An official warm-up period of 3 minutes at the net shall be provided.
- An additional 5 minutes of general play may be permitted.

11. Team Captain Responsibilities

- The Team Captain shall:
- Maintain team discipline and conduct.
- Sign the score sheet before and after the match.
- Represent the team during the toss.
- Communicate with referees when the ball is out of play.

- Seek authorization for uniform/equipment changes, timeouts, verification of service order, and clarification of rules.
- Obtain referee permission before leaving the playing area.

12. Special Play Situations

- In case of simultaneous contact over the net and the ball remains in play, the receiving team is entitled to three hits.
- If the ball lands out after such contact, the fault lies with the opposite team.
- Contact with the antenna after simultaneous play shall result in a replay of the rally.

13. Misconduct and Sanctions

- Stage 1 – Verbal Warning
- Stage 2 – Yellow Card
- Red Card – Penalty
- Red + Yellow (together) – Expulsion
- Red + Yellow (separately) – Disqualification





SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCT AND STAY AT HITS

1. Campus Exit Policy

Once students have entered the university premises, they are not permitted to leave the campus during class hours or activity schedules without prior permission from the concerned authority (such as the Warden, HOD, or Faculty Advisor). Even when permission is granted, students must return before 7:00 PM. Leaving the premises without approval will be treated as a disciplinary violation. This rule ensures safety, accountability, and the smooth functioning of academic and hostel activities.

2. Room Allotment and Personal Safety

Students will be allocated rooms on the ground floor based on the accommodation plan prepared by the administration. For additional security, each student is required to purchase their own lock and key for their assigned room. The university will not be held responsible for any personal belongings lost due to negligence in securing rooms. Students must also ensure that keys are not shared unnecessarily and that rooms remain locked when unoccupied.

3. Restriction on Movement Between Blocks

Students must remain within their allotted hostel block. Moving around or entering other hostel blocks without permission is strictly prohibited. This rule is in place to maintain discipline, privacy, and safety among residents. Violations will be viewed seriously and may lead to warnings or restrictions on hostel privileges.

4. Prohibition of Violence and Ragging

Any act of violence, harassment, or ragging—verbal, physical, or emotional—against fellow students or staff is strictly forbidden. The institution follows a zero-tolerance policy toward ragging, as per UGC and university regulations. Students found guilty of such behavior will face immediate disciplinary action, which may include suspension, expulsion, or legal proceedings. The university promotes a culture of mutual respect, cooperation, and harmony.

5. Damage to College Property

Students are expected to respect and preserve university property. Any damage caused to college infrastructure, such as furniture, laboratory equipment, hostel rooms, or other facilities, whether intentional or accidental, will result in a fine equivalent to the repair or replacement cost. Severe cases may also invite disciplinary measures. Students are urged to treat all facilities as shared community resources.

6. Food and Dining Regulations

Meals will be served in the designated dining areas during the scheduled timings only. Students are expected to adhere to these timings and not demand food outside the allotted hours. Random or unplanned requests for meals at untimely hours will not be entertained, except in case of medical emergencies or prior approvals. Maintaining this discipline ensures smooth kitchen operations and fairness to all students.

7. Dress Code and Campus Decorum

Students must maintain a decent and appropriate dress code while on campus. The following attire is not permitted: shorts, sleeveless tops, crop tops, or short dresses. Dressing modestly reflects respect for the institutional environment and promotes a professional atmosphere. Students failing to follow the dress code may be denied entry to classes or events and will receive a warning.

8. Hostel Entry Restrictions

Strict segregation between boys' and girls' hostels will be maintained at all times. Girls are not allowed inside the boys' hostel, and boys are not allowed inside the girls' hostel under any circumstance. Even for official or academic reasons, such visits are prohibited unless special written permission is obtained from the warden. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disciplinary action.

9. Supervision During Practice Sessions

During any form of sports, cultural, or technical team practice, the team manager or faculty-

in-charge must be present at all times. Teams found practicing without authorized supervision will face consequences such as cancellation of practice privileges or disqualification from representing the university. This ensures accountability, safety, and coordination during practice sessions.

10. Entry Restriction to Event Venues

Only registered participants and their authorized accomplices are permitted entry to the event venue during any university function, competition, or practice session. Entry of outsiders or non-participating students is strictly prohibited for security and organizational reasons. Event coordinators and security personnel have full authority to restrict entry and maintain decorum inside the venue premises.

11. Prohibition of Alcohol and Illegal Substances

The consumption, possession, or bringing of alcohol, narcotic substances, or any form of illegal drugs within the university campus or hostels is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule will attract severe disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion, and possible legal proceedings under applicable laws. The university is committed to maintaining a safe, healthy, and drug-free environment for all students.

12. Cleanliness and Campus Maintenance

Cleanliness and hygiene must be maintained throughout the campus at all times. Students are responsible for ensuring that classrooms, hostels, corridors, and common areas remain tidy. Littering, spitting, or improper waste disposal is strictly prohibited. All waste should be placed in designated bins, and efforts should be made to segregate biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. Maintaining a clean environment reflects personal discipline and respect for shared spaces, contributing to a positive academic atmosphere.

13. Authority and Consequences

The Event Committee and University Authorities hold full power to enforce disciplinary actions in case of any misconduct or violation of the university's code of conduct. Depending on the severity of the offense, actions may include verbal or written warnings, fines, suspension, or expulsion from the institution or event. Participants or visitors involved in serious misconduct may also be reported to their home institutions or relevant authorities. The decisions made by the university administration shall be final and binding on all parties involved.

HOW TO REACH US

Hindustan Institute of Technology & Science (HITS) (Deemed to be University)

By Road

HITS is located on Rajiv Gandhi Salai (OMR/IT Expressway) - about 22 km from Adyar and 12 km before Mamallapuram.

Easily accessible from all parts of Chennai through public transport, cabs, or private vehicles.

Metropolitan Transport Corporation (MTC) buses regularly ply between Adyar / Thiruvanmiyur / Velachery / Tambaram and Kelambakkam.

By Train

The nearest railway station is Velachery MRTS Station (approx. 20 km).

Tambaram Railway Station (on the suburban line) is about 27 km away and well connected by road.

By Air

The nearest airport is Chennai International Airport (MAA), located about 30 km from the campus.
