BBA, B.Com.& BMS Courses

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the eligibility criteria for BBA, B.Com.?

Answer: Candidates who have passed Class 12th/PUC/HSC from any stream are eligible for Admission to BBA, B.Com. Programmes. Additionally, for BBA Logistics and BMS Aviation Services and Air Cargo programmes, students should also clear an Entrance Examination conducted by Logistics Sector Skill Council.

2. Is there any Entrance Exam for BBA, B.Com.Admissions?

Answer: Admission to the BBA course is generally done on the basis of marks secured in Class 12th/HSC/PUC and no separate Entrance Examination will be conducted for the same. However, for the BBA Logistics, BMS Aviation Services and Air Cargo programmes, passing in the Entrance Examination conducted by Logistics Sector Skill Council is mandatory.

3. Is BBA General better or BBA with a specialisation in a specific domain?

Answer:BBA General is a course in which you get an overview of all of the subjects. It is a good choice if you are still undecided about which stream you wish to work in. However, if you are sure about your career path, it is better to choose BBA with a specialization. Additionally, for some sectors such as Tourism Management, Aviation, Logistics, Healthcare or Sports Management, it would always be better to choose a specialized course.

4. Which are the streams offered under BBA in HITS?

Answer: The following streams are offered under the BBA degree programme of HITS:

- BBA General
- BBA Banking and Finance
- BBA Logistics (in collaboration with Logistics Sector Skill Council 3 Semesters of Paid Apprenticeship in Industry)
- BBA Aviation (with IATA Certification Course and Immersive Training at the Orient Flights Aviation Academy, Mysuru)
- BBA Healthcare (in partnership with The Sankara Nethralaya Academy)

5. Is it possible to pursue an MBA degree after BBA?

Answer: Yes, pursuing an MBA degree after graduating from BBA is possible. However, many institutions offering MBA take admissions to the course based on the scores obtained in one of the MBA entrance exams, viz. GMAT, CAT, CMAT, MAT, XAT, NMAT, ATMA, etc. Clearing such exams is always an additional advantage to stand out during Admissions.

Having got an exposure to the concepts in the core domains of management, a BBA graduate will certainly have an edge over others in an MBA programme.

6. What are the higher education prospects after a BCom degree?

Answer:Students who wish to pursue higher studies in Commerce can opt for courses like M.Com., MBA, MA (Hons) in Economics, MBA in Banking & Finance and M.Com. in

Accounting & Finance.

7. Which is a better choice, B.Com. or BBA?

Answer:It absolutely depends on what the learner wishes to pursue as a career. In other words, while, both the degrees may seem to be similar, the course entails a different career prospect for graduates.

If you are interested in commerce, statistics, mathematical analysis of a business or organisation, finance, etc., then B.Com. may be the course of choice for you. However, if you are interested in pursuing a managerial career, then you may choose to pursue BBA as the course for your undergraduate degree.

BBA Logistics Career Opportunities: Customer Service Manager, Analyst, Vehicle Fleet Manager, Inventory Control Manager, Distribution Centre Officer, Purchasing Manager, Import & Export Agent, Freight Coordinator, & Cargo Operations Specialist.
