About the Library

The Dr. K.C.G. Verghese Research and Resource Centre houses over **1,28,119 book** volumes, **5,936** back volumes of national and international journals, and more than **3,500 DVDs**, complemented by access to **25,465+ electronic journals** and **2,43,500+ e books**. The institute subscribes to leading scholarly databases, including **Scopus, IEEE, SAE International, Springer Nature, ScienceDirect, ProQuest (ABI/INFORM and Academic Complete), and Cambridge Journals**, ensuring comprehensive support for advanced teaching and research. The digital library lab is equipped with 60 networked computers and high speed Wi Fi, enabling seamless access to online and cloud based resources, while an additional **10 systems** are dedicated to OPAC and e resource access. Together with well equipped departmental libraries, the central library functions as a vibrant knowledge hub that underpins the institute's teaching, research, and extension activities.

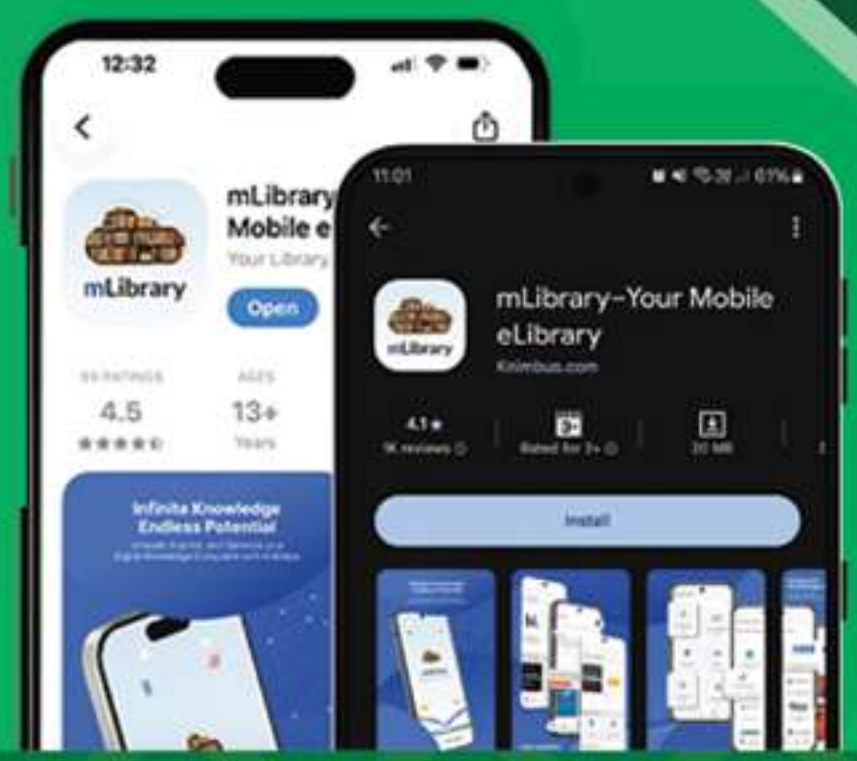
