1. Welcome address by the Vice-Chancellor.

The Vice-Chancellor, Dr. S. N. Sridhara, welcomed the Hon'ble Chancellor, Pro-Chancellor, Executive Director, External members Dr. Rajeev Ahuja, Director, IIT Ropar, Punjab, Dr. C. Emmanuel, Director, Glen Global Health City, Chennai, and Dr. S. P. Thyagarajan, Former Vice-Chancellor, University of Madras (Attended online) and other esteemed members to the 29th Meeting of the Board of Management.

He briefed the agenda of the meeting and invited the Chancellor to address the members of Board of Management.

2. Address by the Hon'ble Chancellor.

Hon'ble Chancellor Dr. Anand Jacob Verghese extended the warm welcome to the external members of eminence and other members and exhorted the gathering with the following.

- Congratulated the members for achieving NAAC accreditation with A+ grade.
- Congratulated Dr. Ashok George Verghese, Pro-Chancellor for successfully completing Doctorate degree in Business Administration at Swiss School of Business and Management, Geneva in the Month of March 2024.
- Informed that the HITS is in the process of launching many new UG and PG programmes in the ensuing academic year 2024-'25 such as B.Sc. Nursing, M.Tech Artificial intelligence etc. and in the process of initiating Off-Campus Centre at Padappai. He requested the guidance and suggestions from the external members for the successful implementation of these new programmes.

3. Confirmation of Minutes of the 28th Meeting of the Board of Management.

The Registrar placed the minutes of the 28th Meeting of the Board of Management held on 16-09-2023 for approval.

The Minutes of the meeting was approved by the members with following suggestions.

- The External Member Dr. S. P. Thygarajan, informed that it is mandatory to submit the registered MOA to UGC as per UGC Regulations 2023 and the statutory body "Board of Management" needs to be re-named as "Executive Council" and he enquired about the status of these aspects. The Chancellor replied that the name of the BOM can be changed as Executive Council from the next meeting. Already draft MOA has been submitted to the UGC and registered MOA will be submitted

upon the receipt of comments from UGC.

- Dr. Rajeev Ahuja informed that there will be a good demand for quantum technologies in the future and many funding agencies are inviting applications for research grants in quantum and also in multiple verticals.
- The Pro-Chancellor directed Dr. N. Manoharan, Director, Projects, to take initiative and guide our faculty to apply for research funding in multiple verticals and specially in quantum technologies in association with IITs. He also suggested to offer M.Sc. programme in Nano Science and Quantum Technologies.
- The Executive Director suggested the faculty to initiate multidisciplinary research projects in collaboration with premier institutions such as IITs. Also, a team can visit IIT Ropar and IIT Gwahathi for observing the lab facilities for Quantum Technology.
- Dr. Rajeev Ahuja also encouraged the students to utilize the Internships offered by AICTE portal.
- Dr. Annie Jacob, Director, informed that the internshala portal is a good platform for internships at core industries and our students can be encouraged to utilize it effectively.

4. Action Taken Report on the Minutes of 28th Meeting of the Board of Management.

The Registrar placed the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the 28th Meeting of the Board of Management held on 16-09-2023 for approval.

The members approved it with the following suggestions.

- The Executive Director suggested to list all the multidisciplinary courses being offered at all the schools as per NEP.
- The Registrar informed that all is set to inaugurate Hindustan Professional Career Academy to offer the coaching classes for civil services exams. Around 500 students have attended the awareness programme and around 25 students have registered for classes.
- Dr. Susan Verghese requested to extend the service to the students from Hindustan College of Arts and Science too and to conduct awareness sessions to enable them to know about the coaching classes.
- The Vice-Chancellor encouraged the HPCA to provide the services to all sister concerns of HITS.

5. Items for presentation:

Dr. Asokan, Dean, Aeronautical Studies presented the following significant Accolades and Achievements bagged by HITS in the last six months.

- Accredited by NAAC with A+ grade, 3.48 point on a 4-point scale.
