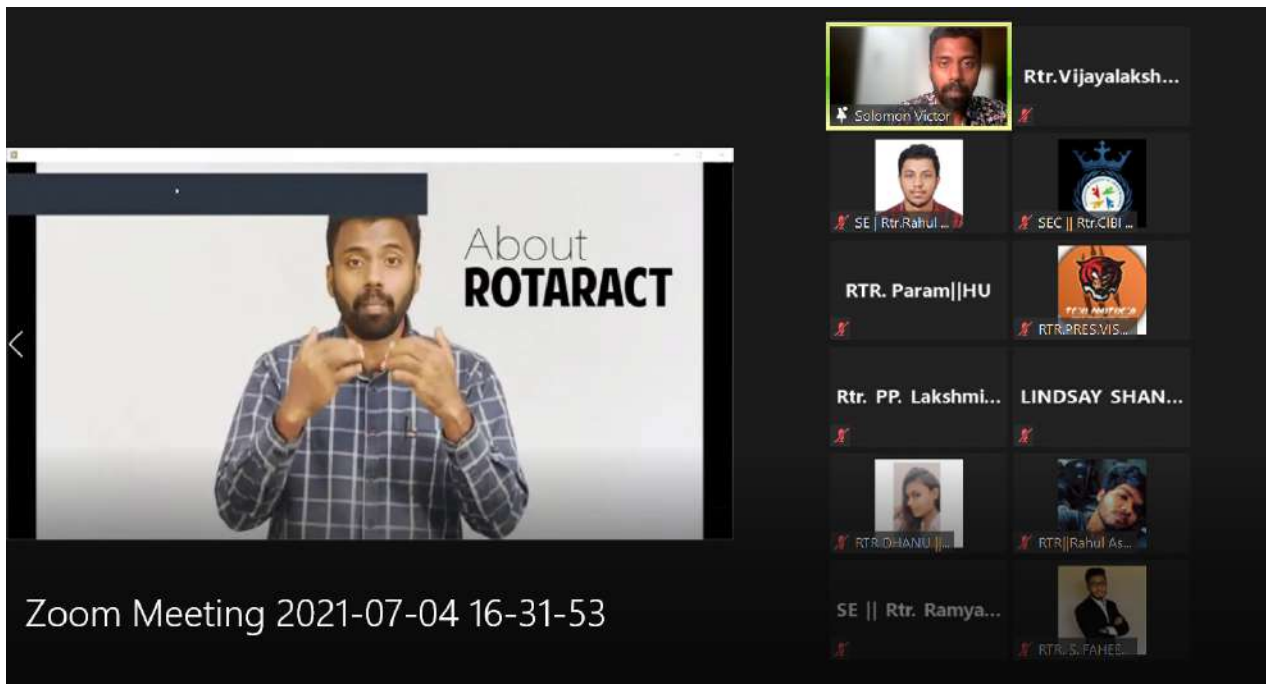
Next Day, the event begin with 9 breakout sessions for the District Officials where speakers were allotted as per their designations.
