

Career Compass 2023 - Report

Every year HITS organises an Open House and this year it was organised as "Career Compass" for School Students studying in 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th Standards. This event enabled students to get an exposure to the various branches of study in our University after schooling as well as scope and area of applications the primary aim was to inspire schools students in Science, E&T, Management, Humanities, Law and Health to name a few. This year the event was organised on 5th and 6th January 2023. We had 2,172 students who attended from 48 schools both private and government schools. The detailed report of the event is as follows:

1. Preparation for the Event

1.1 Conception of Career Compass

The event began with the conception of idea, setting of goals and naming of Open House as Career Compass. The novel ideas of including competitions like Science Quiz, Young Scientist, Elocution and Special Lectures on Startup at School and Robotics and AI along with the career guidance and displays of projects by the departments were incorporated into the 2023.

1.2 Organizing Committees

The core committee comprised of Dr.R.W.Alexander Jesudasan, Pro Vice Chancellor, Dr. Densingh Joshua Israel, Chief Coordinator and Dr. Srideivanai Nagarajan, Coordinator. There were 18 committees set up to work on various activities of the events from visiting schools to the media coverage. A list of the committee members and their roles are present in the **Annexure I.**

1.3 Communication Tools

There was extensive time spent on preparing the creatives. To invite schools, we had prepared an A3 poster for schools notice board, a covering letter signed by Pro Vice Chancellor and

Chief Coordinator addressing to the Heads of the institutions. A promotion video was prepared by the students of MBA Media and Entertainment. Invitation kit detail is given in the Annexure

1.4 Welcome Kit

As an expression of our hospitality, we prepared welcome kits for students, teachers and heads of the institutions. In the welcome kit's refreshments, stationery, Souvenir and admission pamphlet/flyer were given to each worth, student - Rs. 100, Teacher Rs. 300 and Head's - Rs.350. In detail, Kits bags had HITS Brochure, HITS EEE & HITS CAT Pamphlet, notepad, Pen, Cake, Juice Box, a water bottle, in addition to these teacher's kit had a ceramic mug and head's kit had Thermo Coffee Cup.

1.5 Registration and Orientation

A fleet of 40 plus students under the guidance of faculty coordinators worked on the registration aiming to manage the peak inflow of students at ease. For registration school students were directed to OAT and taken for orientation at Good Shepherd Hall guided by NCC Cadets and NSS volunteers. In the orientation students were given a brief introduction about HITS by the Faculty and videos were played for them.

1.6 Transport

To pick up students from the schools in the city and nearby totally 37 trips were made in two days. 20 university buses were used after their routine trips and 3 private buses were hired on day 1. 30 schools opted to use our transport. As a special case, to pick SBOA and Seventh Day Adventist 12th standard students an additional arrangement of 3 private buses were hired under the guidance of the management. In all the buses, our faculty who visited the schools to invite the schools travelled to and to receive and drop the students in a safe manner.

2.Inauguration

The event was inaugurated at the MGR Hall on 5th January, 2023 at 10.00 AM. The Welcome Address was delivered by Dr. Densingh Joshua Israel, Chief Coordinator, Career Compass, The Presidential Address was given by Dr R.W. Alexander Jesudasan, Pro-Vice-Chancellor. Ms. Sherin Someetharan, Additional Commissioner – Customs and GST, Chennai, while inaugurating the event said that this is a great opportunity and a good platform for the school

students to gain confidence and also to know the different career options available after school education. She urged the students to think beyond medicine, engineering and technology and explore the various options available in the field of Arts and Science. Dr Devendran Thirunavukarasu, Founder and CTO, ST Advanced Composites, Shizuoka, Japan and Alumnus of Hindustan Institute of Technology & Science, an alumnus of Hindustan, in his special address advised the students to set their goals and work towards achieving them. He said that the Institution offers other opportunities beyond academics like industrial visits, internships with government agencies and private sectors which helped in building his career. He encouraged the students to make the right decision in choosing their future career paths. Dr.Srideivanai Nagarajan, Coordinator, Career Compass delivered the Vote of thanks. The event presented the students with various options to choose their dream career path.

3. About the Event

3.1 Schools Invited & Participated

School invitation team invited 241 schools in Chennai, Chengelpet and Kanchipuram districts. 100 other schools were invited through emails and calls. The invitations were distributed by dividing the schools into 10 geographical clusters and faculties were assigned for each cluster to visit the schools in their cluster. School invitation was carried out for 5 working days.

3.2 Students Participation

2172 Students from 48 Schools visited HITS Career Compass which include 39 Private schools and 9 Government Schools. 105 Teachers accompanied them. The details of the participation are in **Annexure II.**

4. Special Lectures

Special lectures were organised on the topic "Start-up at School" and Robotics and AI on 5th and 6th January 2023 respectively. Mr. N.V.Chidvilas of Design and Analysis Engineer, DREAM Aerospace, Chennai lectured the students on start-up at school which was attended by 40 students and "Robotics and Artificial Intelligence sessions were handled Expert Professors of HITS which was attended by 34 students.

5. Competitions

Competitions such as Young Scientist, Elocution and Science Quiz were conducted for the private and Government schools to enthuse the students and they won trophies and cash prizes worth Rupees One Lakh. There were 127 registrations for three competitions, split up is given in the tabular column. The prize winners' details are in **Annexure III.**

8. Media Reach

The event has attracted media from print, digital and televisions. There was a press meet immediately after the inauguration, addressed by Pro Vice Chancellor and Registrar. Inauguration was covered by 6 media houses.

9. Conclusion

The event was successfully conducted with the contributions of about 18 committees, 29 departments and other allied services (Annexure VI – Student Photos). There was a review and thanks giving meeting on 12th January 2023 at 3.30pm in the Good Shepherd Hall. All the suggestions mentioned in the meeting were noted for improvements in the next edition of Career Compass.
