



# NCC ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP 2023 | Event Date: Wednesday, 5th, July 2023 -Friday, 14th, July 2023

The NCC Annual Training Camp was held for ten days at the Bay Range Campus between 5-14 July 2023. The camp was organized by the HITS NCC Army Wing.
